Position Profile

Correctional Officers participate in the day-to-day operations of the jail. Officer participation involves, but is not limited to; booking and releasing offenders, maintaining security of the facility, escorting offenders within and /or outside the secure confines of the jail. In addition, Corrections Officer will supervise offender work crews, dispense medications, effectively manage volatile and violent offenders, operate a master control center and fulfill a number of clerical duties.

Qualifications

Must be a minimum of 21 years of age. High School Diploma/GED preferred. Requires completion of Oklahoma Jail School and pass with a minimum score of 70% within 12 months of employment.

Physical Demands

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to use hands to finger, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms; and talk or hear. The employee frequently is required to stand; walk; and stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl. The employee is occasionally required to sit and climb or balance. The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to seventy five (75) pounds. Will be exposed to a physically challenging environment, which may include; exposure to Bloodborne and Airborne pathogens, physical assault, verbal assault, loud noises, prolonged sitting, and restricted movement outside of the facility. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus.
