## Position Profile

Under direction, performs information on County adopted codes, performs field inspections and enforces County code provisions (such as utility permits/inspections, business license, and operations permits) and land use laws pertaining to public welfare, safety, public nuisance, property maintenance and structure design; explains regulations relating to municipal code provisions including zoning, land use, planning, design review, disabled access and related codes to the public; and performs related work as assigned.

## Qualifications

Must have a valid Oklahoma Driver's License. Must be able to pass a pre-employment drug screen. This position makes daily decisions that can be complex in nature and require good judgment in dealing with utility/construction activities and/or property owner issues. High school or G.E.D. equivalent; building trade experience in electrical, plumbing, or mechanical.

## Physical Demands

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this class.
