This Notice shall satisfy the above-cited two separate but related procedural notification requirements.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about March 20, 2018 the Rogers County Board of Commissioners on behalf of Mayes RWD #2 will submit a request to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce (ODOC) for the release of the Community Development Block Grant funds under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, to undertake a project known as EDA Control No. 111304 and 17147 CDBG 18, for the purpose of an water extension line that will take place in the public right-of-ways of Section 18, 17, 07, 08, 06, 05, and 04 of Range 17E, Township 19N, Rogers County, OK. The water distribution line project consists of installation/construction of approximately 26,225 linear feet of 12" water line and 1,275 linear feet of 8" water line in public right of ways with associated appurtenances, crossings and fittings, seeding of disturbed areas and associated engineering, inspection and administration services associated with the project.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The Board of Commissioners of Rogers County on behalf of Mayes RWD #2 has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at the County Clerk's office at 200 South Lynn Riggs Blvd., Claremore, OK 74017 and Grand Gateway Economic Development Association Community Development Office, 333 South Oak Street, Big Cabin, OK 74332-0502 and may be examined or copied weekdays 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency disagreeing with this determination or wishing to comment on the project may submit written comments to the Rogers County Clerk's office. All comments received by March 19, 2018 will be considered by the County of Rogers on behalf of Mayes RWD #2 prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Commentators should specify which part of this Notice they are addressing.

RELEASE OF FUNDS

The Rogers County Board of Commissioners on behalf of Mayes RWD #2 certifies to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce (ODOC) that Dan DeLozier in his capacity as Chairman of Rogers County Board of Commissioners consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. ODOC's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities, and allows the Rogers County on behalf of Mayes RWD #2 to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

ODOC will consider objections to the release of funds and Rogers County on behalf of Mayes RWD #2 certification received by April 4, 2018 or a period of fifteen days from its receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer or other officer of the County of Rogers approved by ODOC (b) Rogers County on behalf of Mayes RWD #2 has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the project have committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by ODOC or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58) and shall be addressed to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce at 900 N. Stiles, Oklahoma City, OK 73104-3234. Potential objectors should contact the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
