

Pursuant to the rules, regulations and policies of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Oklahoma Department of Commerce/ Office of Community Development, this public hearing is being conducted for following purpose:

To provide the citizens of Rogers County Oklahoma and the Rogers County Board of County Commissioners an opportunity to question and receive information on the application for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)/ Economic Development Infrastructure Financing Grant in the amount of approximately \$1,000,000 CDBG/EDIF and \$1,000,000 US Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration leverage funding for the total of \$2,000,000 for water and sanitary sewer infrastructure improvements to accommodate a significant prospect intending to locate a manufacturing facility in the industrial park. The water improvements include the installation of 22,000 linear feet of 12-inch water line, which will connect the industrial site to an existing Mayes County Rural Water District #2 16-inch ductile iron transmission line that currently extends from a point near the Mid America Industrial Park to a point just northeast of Inola in Rogers County. These water infrastructure improvements in southern Rogers County will allow for the flow of 1.5 million gallons of water per day to the site, and will provide utility infrastructure for future industrial growth. Wastewater treatment improvements will consist of the construction of a 380x380 foot retention lagoon, 200 linear feet of 8-inch PVC gravity sewer line, a 100x100 foot lift station site consisting of 4,500 linear feet of 4-inch PVC force main that will be constructed within the Town of Inola and extend to western portion of the industrial site. The wastewater treatment facilities are to be owned and operated by the Town of Inola.

The State of Oklahoma has funds available to units of local government to undertake viable economic development activities that primarily benefit persons defined as low and moderate income. According to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce income guidelines, the project will benefit as at least 51% low and moderate income residents. The purpose of this public hearing is to enable comment on the specific project activities that are proposed and to provide a clear explanation of the probable impacts on the community/county and residents should the project be funded.
