

Countywide trash-off event slated for April

The Rogers County Board of County Commissioners are sponsoring the county's annual "Trash Off" event April 20- 22 at their district warehouses in conjunction with the Keep Oklahoma Beautiful program.

Only non-hazardous waste can be disposed of by county residents (not businesses or commercial enterprises). It is available year-round for residents of Rogers County at each district warehouse.

Non-hazardous items include furniture, mattresses, carpeting, home remodeling debris, tires for cars and light trucks with rims removed, large household items, metal, appliances with refrigerants and CFCs removed and yard debris. Residents are responsible for unloading their own debris.

Commissioners are also sponsoring the county-wide Hazardous Waste Disposal Event with the City of Claremore at the Ne-Mar Shopping Center parking lot (Will Rogers Blvd.) on Saturday, April 22 from 9 a.m. until 2 p.m.

Hazardous waste items accepted at the Ne-Mar Center parking lot include household pollutants such as motor oils, oil-based paints, latex paints, pesticides, weed killers, yard-care products, household cleaners, drain openers, batteries, solvents, corrosive liquids, flammable liquids, glues and fluorescent and CFL bulbs, compressed cylinders, fire extinguishers, oxidizers, liquids and powders.

Items **not accepted** at the county sites or at the Ne-Mar Shopping Center parking lot are household garbage, dead animals, paint or paint products, caustic or hazardous materials, material containing asbestos, compressed gas containers, business or commercial waste, oil, gasoline, diesel or hydrocarbons.
