## **May 3: Emergency Management to host public forum on road safety initiatives**

**Claremore, Okla.** - Rogers County is hosting a proactive forum for public input on Saturday, May 3, from 10AM until noon at the Rogers County Courthouse, located at 200 S. Lynn Riggs Blvd., on the second floor.

This forum aims to gather public input for developing a comprehensive safety action plan designed to prevent roadway fatalities and serious injuries over the next five years and beyond.

The forum will focus on identifying current areas that support planning, infrastructure, and behavioral/operation initiatives to prevent fatalities and serious injuries on rural county roads, including pedestrians, bicyclists, public transportation, motorists, and commercial vehicle operators by proposing improvements to enhance road safety in Rogers County.

If funding is awarded, which consists of 80% federal and 20% local contributions, the approved scope of work must be completed within five years.

The Rogers County Emergency Management team and the Safe Roads Committee encourage community members to participate and share their suggestions.
